Minutes of Apache School Board Training November 14, 2018

Attending were board members Alicia Davidson, Dean Nelson, and Maurine Joens. Also attending were Business Manager, Tamara Winkler, Head Teacher, Loy Guzman, and two members of the public. The training meeting concluded at 4:25 pm.

Minutes of Apache School Board Regular Meeting November 14, 2018

I. PRELIMINARY MATTERS

- **A.** The Apache Governing Board met in it's regular meeting November 14, 2018, 5:00 pm, at the Apache School. The meeting was called to order by board president, Mrs. Davidson.
- **B.** The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by Mrs. Davidson.
- **C.** In attendance were board members Alicia Davidson, Dean Nelson, and Maurine Joens. Also in attendance were Head Teacher, Loy Guzman, Business Manager, Tamara Winkler, and two members of the public.
- **D.** Mrs. Davidson moved to adopt the agenda of the November 14, 2018, regular school board

- E. Mrs. Davidson moved that the minutes of the September 12, 2018, regular board meeting, the minutes of the October 10, 2018, regular board meeting, and the minutes of the October 10, 2018, Hearing be approved as submitted. Dean Nelson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- F. Mrs. Joens moved to adopt the Consent Agenda. Mrs. Davidson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. The Consent Agenda consisted of Ratification of Expense Vouchers 1904 and 1905; Ratification of Payroll Vouchers 7 and 8; Approval of Treasurer's Deposits 123540, 122864, 123028, and 123561; and accept into Gifts and Donations Fund (Fund 530) \$100 from Mary and John Lacey for books and supplies, \$50 from Delane Blondeau for books and supplies, and \$50 from Joan Jenson for books and supplies.

III. HEAD TEACHER REPORT

- **A.** We have an awesome Business Manager who did not allow a direct deposit paycheck fraud to happen.
- **B.** We will be applying for grants given to schools by Sheriff Daniels for \$1000 or more. We will be applying for grants for our birding area, playground, greenhouse, and one more.
- **C.** The students are writing a newspaper. Included will be articles about their trip to Apple Annie's, their trip to Portal, and also an article about bullying.
- **D.** There are currently 7 students enrolled. Two have moved.

E. The Tombstone project is finished and now the students are learning about the difference between ranches and farms. The students will be going to Billy Grossman's meat processing plant to see what takes place there.; The students will also be taking a field trip to a farm and also to the cotton gin in Kansas Settlement.

- **G.** Tuesday Mrs. Roberts will bring a Thanksgiving dinner for the students. The students will make cards about what Thanksgiving means to them and also cards giving thanks to someone.

IV. BUSINESS MANAGER REPORT

- A. There have been a lot of meetings lately. There will be a two day meeting in Tucson, Infinite Vision, which will be free software training. Tomorrow is a meeting by the Attorney General's office giving financial coding training. Mrs. Winkler reported that she learns as much from counterparts at the meeting as she learns in the meetings. Proposal A added a statement to ASBA's core beliefs: Every school board has the responsibility to champion and pursue educational equity for every student by challenging systemic inequities.
