Pursuant to A.R.S. 38.431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Apache Elementary School District #42 community that the Apache School District Board of Education will hold a meeting open to the public on the second Tuesday of each month beginning at 5:30 pm at the Apache Elementary School. To accommodate board members and staff, date and time of regular board meetings may be changed and will be announced in the posting of that meeting's agenda in advance. Pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03, the board may vote to move into executive session at any time to consult with the board attorney in person or via telephonic conference call on any matters listed on the agenda. "Call to the Public" is not an open discussion with the Board and Head Teacher.
